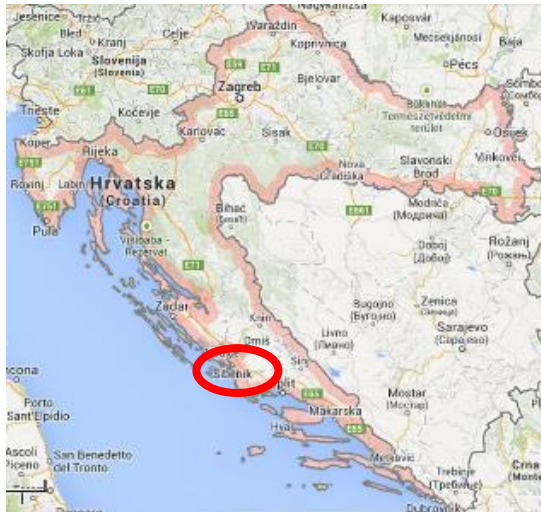

Venue and Accommodation

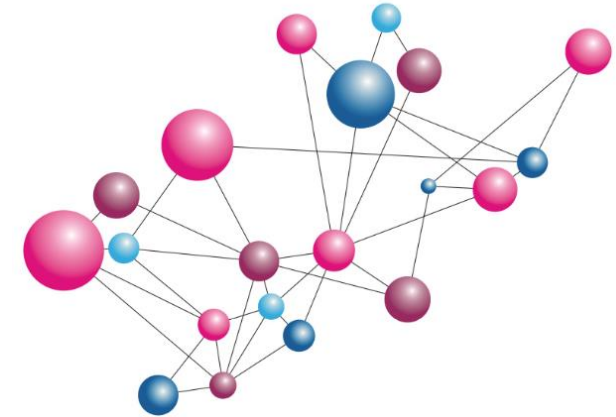
